



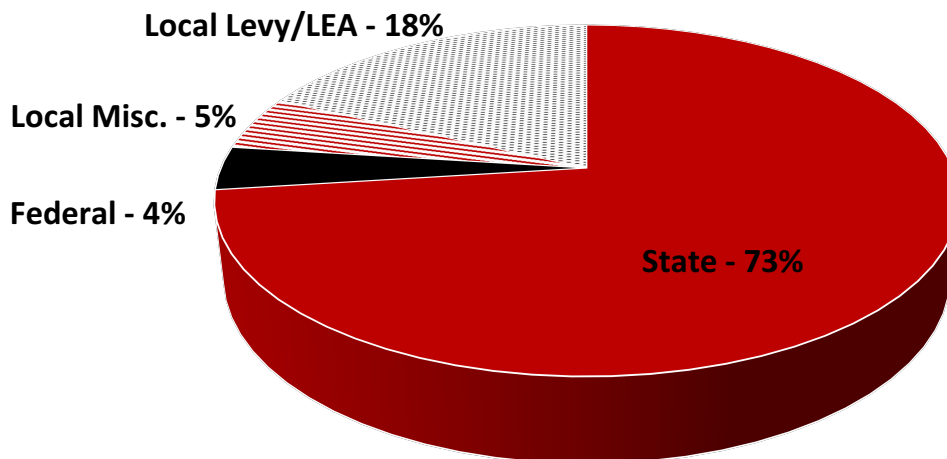
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS REPLACEMENT LEVY

WHAT IS A REPLACEMENT LEVY?

This levy used to be called a “Maintenance and Operations Levy.” The word “Replacement” was added to reflect the fact that the existing levy has expired (every two years).

The Educational Programs and Operation Replacement Levy is a provision to support and enrich the instructional needs of the school district that are not fully funded by the state.

ENDICOTT SCHOOL FUNDING



WHAT DOES THE LEVY SUPPORT?

- Vocational program expenses not fully covered by state funding.
- All extracurricular programs such as band and all athletic programs.
- Food Service in excess of revenues to provide the quality of meals that our students receive.
- School operational expenses such as utilities, insurance and building maintenance that is not fully funded by the state.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The levy is used to maintain programs and facilities we have.
- The February 2018 levy will replace the current 2-year levy due to expire in 2018.
- The levy is designed to sustain the current quality programs offered by Endicott School District.

WHAT WILL THE LEVY COST TAX PAYERS?

Proposed

2019	\$370,000	\$3.03 per \$1000 assessed value
2020	\$370,000	\$2.94 per \$1000 assessed value
